Crime Free Multi-Housing (CFMH) is a crime prevention program that works with property owners, managers, tenants and Saskatoon Police Service officers to reduce opportunities for crime, vandalism, drugs, and gang activity in rental properties. On average, Saskatoon CFMH reduces the incidents of crime in rental properties by 25%.

5 CFMH STRATEGIES

Crime Prevention Through Environmental Design (CPTED)

Use building design and maintenance to detect and deter criminal activity. Demonstrate ownership, control access to private areas, and strategically increase visibility.

Applicant Screening
