QUICK COMMUNICATION TIPS

- Please face me as eye contact is necessary.
- Speak slowly and clearly in a normal tone, do not cover your mouth.
- Repeat, rephrase or write your request.
- Be patient, give me a chance to understand.
- I may have vision loss as well.
- Reduce background noise or flashlight use that may interfere with communication.
- An interpreter or other support might be required.
